

**AERIAL PHOTOGRAPHY PROJECT INDEX MAP
FOR MN DNR PHOTOS FLOWN AT 1:31,680**

This index map depicts where the aerial photograph centers are located on the ground for each 1:31,680 scale photo.

To produce 1:15,840 scale photos, the southeast and southwest quarters was cropped out of each 1:31,680 photo and relabeled by multiplying the flightline by 2 for the new SE quarter photo and multiplying the flightline by 2 and subtracting 1 for the new SW quarter photo. The exposure number stays the same for both. The resulting photos were then printed at 9" by 9".

To get the stereo pairs for the new 1:15,840 photographs, the next 1:31,680 photo south is cropped at an 80% overlap to the new photos.

For example: the 1:31,680 photo labeled lak-21-005 is cropped to produce the following 1:15,840 scale photos:

- lak-41-004 stereo which is the east central portion of the photo and is used as the stereo pair for lak-41-004.
- lak-41-005 which is the southeast quarter portion of the photo and is used as a base 1:15,840 photo.
- lak-42-004 stereo which is the west central portion of the photo and used as the stereo pair for lak-42-004.
- lak-42-005 which is the south west quarter portion of the photo and is used as a base 1:15,840 photo.
