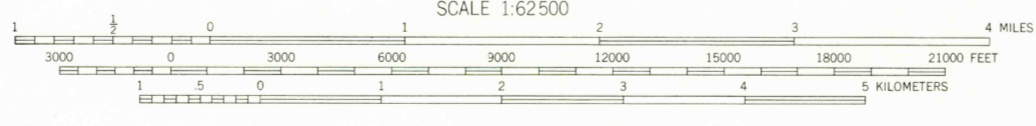


THIS AREA SHOWN ON THE
