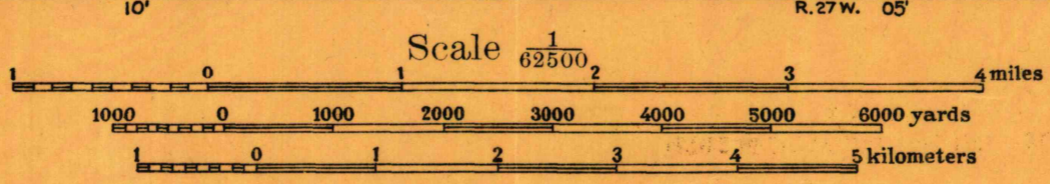


CORPS OF ENGINEERS, U. S. ARMY
PROGRESSIVE MILITARY MAP



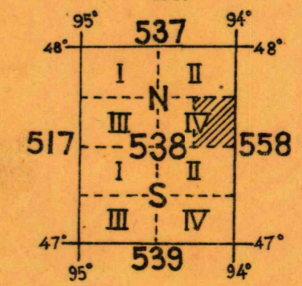
