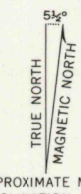

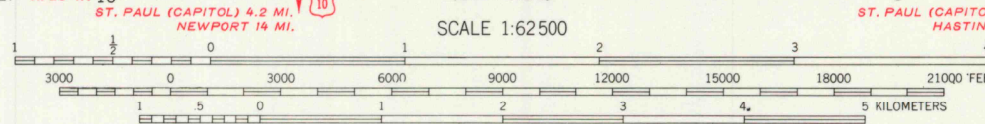
10,000-foot grid based on Minnesota coordinate system, south zone
